This Indenture made this 10th day of October 1809 between
 Burwell Beal and Cherry his wife of the County of Southampton
 of the one part and John Rochelle of the said County of the other
 part. Witnesseth that the said Burwell Beal and Cherry
 his wife for and in Consideration of the Sum of One hundred
 pounds to them in hand paid by the said John Rochelle
 before the writing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
 he the said Burwell Beal doth hereby acknowledge himself to be
 therewith fully satisfied Contented and paid hath granted bargain
 & sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell
 unto the said John Rochelle his heirs and assigns forever, One
 Certain Tract or parcel of lands lying and being in the County
 of Southampton aforesaid and bounded as follows (To wit) Beginning
 At a maple tree a corner of Stephen Hancock & Jordan Edwards
 Tract, thence a North East Course by a line of marked trees of the
 said Edwards's line to a small turkey oak a corner tree of
 the aforesaid Edwards's line and John Rochelle Senr. & Co's
 line thence by the said Rochelle's line to a large white oak on the
 Side of Dick Swamp and thence up the various Courses of the said
 Swamp to the beginning containing by Estimation One hundred
 acres more or less - To have and to hold the said tract or
 parcel of lands together with all and singular the appurtenances
 thereon unto the said John Rochelle his heirs and assigns
 forever against the Claim of them the said Burwell Beal
 and Cherry his wife their heirs and assigns and against the Claim
 and demands of any other person whatsoever claiming or
 demanding the same or any part thereof - In Witness whereof
 they the said Burwell Beal and Cherry his wife have hereunto
 set their hands and affixed their Seals the day and year
 first above written
