Purposes herein after mentioned all of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Wilmot that the Said John Day and Harriet his wife for and in Consideration of the Sum of One Dollar to them in hand paid at and upon the Sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained Sold Released and Conveyed and by these presents doth give grant bargain Sell release and Convey unto him the said John Woodard John Carr Brittain Barnes Reubin Pope William Bryant William Whitehead Jesse Battle and their Successors (Trustees in trust for the uses and purposes herein after mentioned and declared) all the State right title interest properly claim and demands whatsoever either in Law or Equity which he the Said John Day and Harriet his wife hath in to upon all and Singular a certain lot or piece of ground Situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and on the South side of Notoway River bounded and buttet as follows to wit. Beginning at Sweet Gum in the edge of Barnes Mill Swamp from thence a line of marked trees to a persimmon tree Corner 85 yards from thence a straight line to a sweet Gum on the west side the great Road 83 yards from thence Crossing the road straight along a line of marked trees to a white Oak Standing in the Edge of the aforesaid Swamp 130 yards up the North Edge Swamp to the Beginning Containing by estimation $4\frac{1}{2}$ acres of Ground together with all Singular the houses woods waters ways privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold all and Singular the above mentioned and described lot or piece of Ground Situate lying and being as aforesaid together with all and Singular the houses woods waters ways and privileges thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto him the said John Woodard John Carr Brittain Barnes Reubin Pope William Bryant William Whitehead and Jesse Battle and their Successors in office forever in trust that
