This Indenture made this 25<sup>th</sup> day November 1808  
 Bore eight hundred and nine Between David Davis and Susanna  
 Davis his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Bird  
 Howell of the aforesaid County of the other part. Witnesseth, that the said  
 David Davis & his wife Susanna. for and in Consideration of the Sum  
 of One thousand dollars, to them in hand paid by the said Bird How-  
 ell the receipt whereof the said David Davis & Susanna his wife  
 doth hereby acknowledge themselves fully satisfied & Contented.. Hath  
 granted, Bargained and sold, alien, enfeoffed and Confirmed, and by  
 these presents doth grant, bargain, Sell, alien enfeoff and Confirm unto  
 the said Bird Howell and to his heirs & assigns forever all that tract  
 or parcel of land whereon the said David Davis now lives Containing  
 nearly four acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands  
 of Henry Sumner on the north George Bailey on the west Thomas  
 Britton on the South and the lands of the aforesaid Bird Howell  
 on the east With all the profits, Commodities, and advantages, whate-  
 ver to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining and also the  
 Reversion, & reversions, remainders and remainders, rents and ser-  
 vices of the said premises and every part & parcel thereof To have  
 & to hold all & singular the said premises as above mentioned Every  
 part, & parcel thereof, with the appurtenances unto the said Bird  
 Howell his heirs and assigns, to the only use & behoof of him the  
 said Bird Howell his heirs and assigns forever. We as further
