This Indenture made the fifteenth day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred & six Between Benjamin Wistray of the County of Southampton and Parish of Totterway of the one part and Garden Denson of the same County and Parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Wistray for and in Consideration of the just and full sum of four hundred and sixteen dollars and eighty Cents by the said Garden Denson to him in hand paid before the enclosing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Benjamin Wistray doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Garden Denson his heirs & assigns forever and himself therewith fully and intirely Satisfied Contented and paid the said Benjamin Wistray hath granted bargain - & sold and aliened enfeoffed released set over delivered and Confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoffed release set over deliver and Confirm unto the said Garden Denson and to his heirs and assigns forever all that plantation meadow tract and parcel and parcel of land wherein the said Benjamin Wistray now lives and being the same he purchased of Nathan Porter Situate in the County of Southampton and Parish of Totterway aforesaid Containing by estimation Ninety three acres be the same more or less bounded and described as by the said Deeds deed to the said Wistray is expressed also all that plantation meadow tract and parcel of land whereon Robert Newnam me being the same that the said Benjamin Wistray purchased of Thomas Camp situate in the County of Southampton and Parish of Totterway aforesaid Containing by estimation sixty seven acres be the same more or less and bounded as by the said Camps deed to the said Wistray is expressed and declared. And all the houses out - houses Edifices buildings woods ways waters and watercourses profits Commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging Or in anywise appertaining and the reversion
