This Indenture, made the Eighteenth day of Nov^r in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine, and in the thirty fourth year of the Commonwealth of Virginia Between Moses Johnson and Polly Johnson his wife, of the parish of Mattoway and County of Southampton of the One part, and Solomon Holmes of the Parish and County aforesaid of the other part, Witnesses, That for and in Consideration of the Sum of sixty six Pounds, by the Said Solomon Holmes to the Said Moses Johnson in hand Delivered at or before the Sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof the Said Moses Johnson doth hereby acknowledge that the Said Moses Johnson and Polly Johnson his wife, have granted bargained, Sold, Alien'd, Enfeoff and Confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain, Sell, Alien, release Enfeoff and Confirm unto the said Solomon Holmes, his heirs and assigns for ever and all that tract or parcel of Land (formerly part of the property of Benjamin Britt Jun^r Deceased, and premises Situate lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid Containing by Estimation sixty six Acres, More or less and bounded as follows to wit By the line of Solomon Holmes Moses Johnson Matthew Britt and Lucy Williamam, the same being a part of a tract
