 in Consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars Current Money of
 Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Amos Stephenson, the one
 whereof the said John Johnson doth hereby acknowledge, have granted
 bargained and sold, alien and Confirm, and by these presents do grant
 bargain & sell alien and Confirm unto the said Amos Stephenson
 his heirs and assigns forever, One certain Tract or parcel of land
 containing One hundred and twelve 1/2 Acres, more or less being &
 lying in the County of Southampton, bounded as followeth —
 Wit- Beginning at a Scrubby white Oak, between Wm. Blount
