Shilling Current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid  
by the said Richard Hallcome before the sealing and  
delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof be the said S J Bell  
doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge  
the said Hallcome his heirs executors and administrators and  
themselves therewith fully and entirely satisfied Contented and  
paid be the said S J Bell hath granted bargained sold  
alred released Setover deliver infofted and confirmed unto  
the said Richard Hallcome his heirs and assigns forever all by the  
presents doth grant Bargain sell alien infofted release set over  
deliver and confirm unto the said Richard Hallcome his heirs  
and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of land situate  
lying and being in the County of Southampton as aforesaid contain-  
ing by Estimation Fifty Seven and three quarter acres of land to  
be the same more or less and bounded as followeth Now
