this nineteenth day of May One thousand eight hundred and nine by & between Abridgton Jones and Polly Jones his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Willis Munroe of the same County and State of the other part - Witness - so that the said Abridgton Jones and Polly Jones for and in Consideration of the Sum of sixty six pounds ten Shillings to them in hand paid by the said Willis Munroe at and before them - Sealing and delivery of these presents the full receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged ^{from which} which the said Willis Munroe and all his legal representatives are forever exonerated and discharged, have bargained sold alien transferred enfeoffed & confirmed and by these presents do bargain sell alien transfer enfeoff and confirm unto the said Willis Munroe his heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land Situate lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid Containing by Survey sixty six acres and One half acre and bounded as follows. Beginning at a hickory Corner tree in the said Willis Munroe's line running thence N 81 E 54 pole to a hickory Corner tree in Elias Edwards line thence N 49 E 101 pole to a small maple a new corner made in said Elias Edwards line thence N 25 W 16 pole to a pine a new corner in the said Elias line thence S 83 W 4 pole to a red oak standing on the side of the road leading from Brownes Ferry to Black water Bridge
