At a Court held for the County of Southampton the Day of Oct^r 1809 this Indenture was proved by the oath of Thomas Emelly one of the witnesses thereto continued; and at a Court held for said County the day of Jan^y 1810 This Indenture was acknowledged Daniel Simmons party hereto and with a Commission for the percy examination of Mrs Elizabeth Simmons & certificate of its execution returned & ordered to be recorded

This Indenture made this 18th day of Dec^r the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and more between Evans Pope of the One part and of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia and Joseph Pope of the said County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Evans Pope for and in consideration of the sum of ^{Five} ~~Five~~ Dollars Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Pope at or before the sealing and delivery of these
