

70 Jones cannot conveniently travel to the Court of our said County to acknowledge the same therefore we do give to you power to receive the acknowledgement which the said Mary Jones shall be willing to make before you of the Conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is hereto annexed and we do command you to go personally to the said Mary Jones and examine her privately and apart from her husband whether she hath executed the said deed freely and voluntarily without the persuasion or threats of her said husband and whether she is willing the same should be recorded in the County Court of Southampton and when you have examined her as aforesaid and taken her acknowledgement of the same that you do timely and openly certify us thereof under your hands and seals returning to us also this writ with the said Indenture annexed With of Samuel Kello Clerk of our said Court at his office the 3^d day of June 1809 and in the 3^d year of the Commonwealth

Know all men by these presents that I James Vick of the County of Southampton for and in Consideration of the natural Love and affection which I bear to my Son William Vick of said County as well as for the further Consideration of One dollar in hand paid by the said William Vick at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereto annexed — I have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said William Vick his heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns three acres of Land of said Williams Chosen &
