

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 25th day of January 1810 This Indenture was acknowledged by Evans Pope ^{parties} and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this 15th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and ten between John Smith of the State of N. Carolina and County of Wain of the one part and ^{County} ~~James~~ Summerselle of the State of Virginia and Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Smith for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and forty pounds four Shilling Current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said ~~James~~ Summerselle, at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I the said John Smith doth hereby acknowledge and myself therewith to be fully satisfied and thereof doth clearly acquit and discharge ~~James~~ Summerselle his heirs Exors and assigns forever by these presents Heath given granted bargained sold uncoffed and confirmed & by these presents doth give grant bargain sell uncoff and confirm unto the said ~~James~~ Summerselle his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of ^{land} containing by estimation four hundred and thirty three acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County Southampton and bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a pine a corner tree of Wiley Dole's line from thence a line of marked trees to a red oak a corner tree of James Johnson and Garden Tayners line from thence down a branch to a cypress ^{a line of marked trees to a black gum a corner tree of the line of James Johnson, from thence down a branch to a cypress} a line of James Johnson from thence a line of marked trees to a water oak standing on the rim of Seacoe Swamp so down the said Swamp to the mouth of the Mury Branch to a post oak a line of John Lawrence from thence a line of marked trees to a black gum standing in Morris's branch so up the said branch to a pine of Wiley Dole's line from thence
