This Indenture made this 2nd June 1870 Between John Anderson on the first part, Nathan Williams on the second part and Lewis Worrell on the third part all of the county of Southampton Witnesseth that whereas the said Nathan Williams doth in several instances stand security for said Anderson viz^t Wm Maget, Edwin Baykin, Benjⁿ Sumner & Jacob Garden Now the said Anderson being willing & desirous to Secure unto him the said Williams the payment of the several debts, together with other obligations he the said Williams is bound in for him the said Anderson and he the said Anderson doth by these presents (for the purpose above mentioned) and for the further Consideration of One dollar to him in hand paid at the delivery of these presents have bargained & sold unto him the said Lewis Worrell his heirs
