the one part and Willie Francis, of the said County, of the other part, Wit-
nesseth that the said Cordall Read and Deliah his wife, for and in con-
sideration of Sum of nine hundred and forty five dollars in hands to them
paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted bargained
and sold, by these presents, do grant bargain sell release and confirm unto
the said Willie Francis, his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land
whereon the said Cordall Read now resides lying and being in the aforesaid
County of Southampton, on the North side of the great Swamp
