At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the Day of February 1810 This Indenture was acknowledged by Cordall Read & Delilah his wife parties hereto she being first privately examined as the law directs & ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this 5th day of February in the year of our Lord Christ Eighteen hundred and ten between Charles Bryant and Temperance his wife both of the County of Southampton of the One part and James Mountfort of the Same County of the other part Witnesseth that the Charles Bryant and Temperance his wife for and in consideration of the Sum of five hundred and forty four dollars and fifty Cents lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the Said James Mountfort the receipt whereof the Said Charles Bryant and Temperance his wife doth acknowledge themselves fully and amply Satisfied and paid hath granted, Bargained sold, Alienated, ^{conveyed} & Confirmed and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the Said James Mountfort One certain tract or Parcel of Land and Premises whereon Joshua Beel formerly lived being a part of the Said plantation containing by a late Survey one hundred and twenty one acres be the Same more or less and bounded as follows (To Wit) Beginning at a large Pine a corner in James Edwards's line running thence South 45 degrees west to Kottaway Swamp, thence the Various Courses of the Said Swamp to James Scott's line thence along James Scott's line of marked trees to a white Oak a corner in his line, ^{thence} N. 37 - East
