At a court held for the county of Southampton the Day February 1870 This Indenture was acknowledged by Jesse and his wife/parties hereto she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this eleventh day of January anno domini one thousand eight hundred and ten, between John Johnson and Edna Johnson his mother of the one part and Henry Lenow of the other part each and all of the county of Southampton Witneseth that the said John Johnson and Edna his mother for and in consideration of the sum of eighty five dollars and 25 cents current money of Virginia to them in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents, do grant bargain and sell, convey and confirm unto the said Henry Lenow and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county of Southampton containing twenty three acres be there the same more or less being part of tract of land be John Johnson and given John Johnson by Madrack Johnson, husband and parent - Brought as followeth, to wit, beginning at a sweet gum in the head of a small branch at the mouth thereof along the road 8 ft. or so pole to a black gum in the little branch, thence down said branch, Pierces line to Suckahannah Swamp, thence down said Swamp to a black gum in the marsh, the beginning branch thence up the side branch to the beginning, to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land to the said Henry Lenow and to his heirs and assigns to their only use and behoof, forever and the said John Johnson and Edna his mother
