This Indenture made this 18th day of Jan'y one thousand

eight hundred & ten between Benjamin Westray and Nancy his wife
of the County of Southampton of the one part and Rebecca Meeome
of Said County of the other part Witnesseth, that the said Benjⁿ
Westray Nancy his wife for and consideration of the sum of one
hundred pounds by the said Rebecca Meeome to her in hand paid
the receipt whereof the said Benjⁿ Westray and Nancy doth hereby
acknowledge and themselves fully satisfied, contented and paid, the said
Benjamin Westray and Nancy his wife hath granted bargained, and sold,
aliened enfeoffed released set over deliver and confirmed and by these presents
doth grant, bargain, sell, alien enfeoffed released, set over and confirm
unto the said Rebecca Meeome and to her heirs & assigns forever
all that plantation, meadow, tract & parcel of land, whereon the
said Benjamin Westray now lives, being the same that the said
Benjamin Westray purchased of Thomas Camp, situate in the
