

state of said of the third part, the said Elizabeth Ridley did thereby & therein grant bargain and sell aliend in feoff releas and Confirm unto me the said William Mafenburg all her right- title interest- state claim & demand, of in and to seven Slaves following to wit- Currel, Sam york Jordyce, Betty and Chlo, Chlod Sue Jemmy Doum and alford, and two beds and furniture one Chest with drawers and one reading Chair and Horse, for the intents, uses purposes and Conditions in the said recited Indenture expresed, which said Interest- uses purposes and Conditions, provisions and limitations, are in the said Indenture written in the following words (to wit-) upon trust and Special Confidence nevertheless and it is hereby declared concluded- covenanted and agreed by and between the respective parties to this Indenture for themselves their heirs executors and administrators respectively and the said William Mafenburg for himself his heirs executors and administrators- doth in particular- Covenant- promise and agree to and with the said Elizabeth Ridley her heirs executors administrators and assigns that he the said William Mafenburg his heirs and assigns shall stand seized and possessed of the said Slaves and other property hereby before conveyed or intended to be conveyed to him the said William Mafenburg his heirs and assigns with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining- upon and under and subject and liable to the several trusts, uses, intents purposes, provisions Conditions and agreements herein after declare and expressed (that is to say) In trust- for the said Elizabeth Ridley her heirs executors and assigns until the solemnization of the said intended Marriage and from and immediately after the solemnization of the said intended marriage then- and in trust- that the said William Mafenburg his heirs and assigns shall permit- and suffer the said Etheldred Taylor during the coverture and intermarriage agreed- to have receive & take to the proper use and behoef of him the said Etheldred Taylor and Elizabeth Ridley, all the rents, Issues profits services benefite and hires which shall during the coverture and intermarriage aforesaid accrued or be made by- out of, or from the said Slaves and other property provided always, and it is further agreed, covenanted intended stipulated and concluded between all and every of the parties to this Indenture for themselves their heirs executors administrators and assigns respectively that if at any time during the coverture and intermarriage aforesaid it shall happen that the said Etheldred Taylor shall fortune to fall in his circumstances, or
