

becomes insolvent, or if it shall fortune that the said Etheldred Taylor
 shall at any time during the coverture and Intermariage aforesaid, alien, give,
 grant, or sell the said slaves and other property or any parcel of the same
 to any person or persons whatsoever or whomever, that then and in either
 of the two before last mentioned cases the said last mentioned trust shall
 cease and be void; and from and immediately after such failure and insolven-
 cy of him the said Etheldred Taylor or of such sale alienation, gift or
 grant by him made that the said William Maffsenburg his heirs and
 assigns stand seized and possessed of the said slaves and other property
 with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise
 appertaining upon and under and subject and liable to the several trust
 uses intents purposes provisions conditions and agreements herein after expressed
 (that is to say) In trust to receive and pay over the rents issues profits
 hires and benefits arising accruing or in any manner growing out of the
 same for maintenance and support of her the said Elizabeth Ridley during
 the coverture and intermarriage aforesaid; and from and after the coverture
 and intermarriage aforesaid; then in trust for the said Elizabeth Ridley
 her heirs executors administrators or assigns, but if it shall happen that
 the said Etheldred Taylor do not fail in his circumstances or becomes
 insolvent as aforesaid of the said slaves and other property or any part
 thereof during the intermarriage & coverture aforesaid then after the inter-
 marriage and coverture aforesaid he the said William Maffsenburg his heirs
 & assigns shall stand seized and possessed of the said slaves and other property
 with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise
 appertaining, In trust for the said Elizabeth Ridley her heirs exors admors
 or assigns forever If she that said Elizabeth Ridley shall fortune to survive
 and survive the said Etheldred Taylor: But and if the said Elizabeth Ridley
 shall fortune to depart this life living the said Etheldred Taylor then
 the said William Maffsenburg his heirs and assigns shall stand seized and
 possessed of the said slaves and other property with all and singular the
 appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining In trust for
 the heirs and legal representatives of her the said Elizabeth Ridley forever
 if she fortune to die intestate; but and if the said Elizabeth Ridley shall die
 & estate and shall by her testament and last will in writing duly published
 and declared according to law bequeath and devise the same or any part
 or parcel thereof to any person or persons whatsoever Then In trust
