This Indenture made the fourteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine between Simeon Whitehead and Edward Browne executors of James Browne deceased of the one part and Doctor Samuel Browne of the County of Southampton of the other part. Whereas James Browne by his last will and testament which is duly recorded in the Court of Norfolk County did direct his executors to sell and dispose of his plantation on nettoway river in the County of Southampton if in their opinion it should be necessary for the payment of his debts or to the interest of his estate and whereas the said executors have deemed it necessary both for the interest of his estate and the payment of his debts that the said plantation should be sold they have accordingly sold the same to the said Samuel Browne for the sum of one thousand two hundred and fifty dollars, Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Simeon Whitehead and Edward Browne executor of James Browne deceased for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand two hundred and fifty dollars to the said Edward Browne in hand paid by the said Samuel Browne the receipt of which by him is hereby acknowledged Have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of him as executors aforesaid bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Browne his heirs & assigns all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being on nettoway river in County of Southampton containing by estimation two hundred acres more or less which was set apart and allotted to the said James Browne by Commissioners appointed by the Court of Southampton County to divide the lands of the late Doctor Samuel Browne and is signified in their report of record in said Court by number six together with all and singular the appurtenances of every nature and description to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining. It have and do hold the aforesaid land with the tenements, hereditaments and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned unto and to be bargained & sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members & appurtenances unto the said Samuel Browne his heirs and assigns forever. In Witness whereof the said Simeon Whitehead & Edward Browne have hereunto set their hands & affixed their seals as executors aforesaid the day & year first herein written.
