 bargain, sell, alien, give and confirm unto her the said Martha Chamell
 one her has a certain or parcel, lying and being in the aforesaid County and
 containing by estimation thirty six acres be the same more or less & bounded as
 follows to wit: beginning at a mulberry tree a corner in said Chamells and Bry-
 ants line, thence running westwardly as the line is marked sixty five poles
 to a red oak a corner thence Southwardly to a branch sixty four poles,
 thence down the said branch to a Holly tree in the mouth of the Spring branch
 forty two poles, thence up the said branch to a pine in a grove, thence said line
 to a black oak a corner in said Chamells line seventy eight pole thence
 North along said Chamells line to the beginning eighty poles. To have
 & to hold unto her the said Martha Chamells her heirs and assigns
 forever all right title, property & Interest, in and to the said land and its
 appurtenances. And they the said Burwell Bryant and Susannah his wife
 for themselves and each of them here do by these presents, Warrant and will

 May 1813 This Indenture was acknowledged by Burwell Bryant and Susannah
 Bryant parties unto the being first privately examined as the law directs
 and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this 21st Day of May one thousand
 eight hundred & ten between Lawrence Bishop of the one part and James Bishop
 of the other part both of Southampton County Witnesses that the said Law-
 rence Bishop for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds current
 money of Virginia lawfully granted and by these presents doth grant and confirm unto
 and the said James Bishop his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land
 by estimation containing 35th acres more or less and bounded as followeth to wit
 the line of Burwell Beal on the South the line of the Ephraim of John B. Echelle
 on the west by Burwell Beal and the aforesaid Ephraim on the North and
 Samual Drake and Drury Beal on the east. It being a part of
