

67 This Indenture made this eighth day of February in the year
 of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and ten between William West
 and Crespy his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and John
 West of the other Wm West and Crespy his wife have for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five pounds
 ten shillings & sixpence to them in hand paid at or before the making and deli-
 very of these presents have granted bargained and sold and by these presents
 do grant bargain and sell unto the said John West his heirs or assigns forever
 one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County
 of Southampton and bounded as follows Vizt Beginning at a pine in a small
 branch thence up the said branch to a corner into oak in Jones's thence along
 the said Jones's line nearly west 98 ft to a black gum in the lightwood ground
 thence down the main run of said Swamp to a small branch in the lower
 line thence up said Branch to a small Black gum a corner thence along
 a new line of marked trees to the beginning pine or first station containing by
 late survey fifty acres be the same more or less together with all lands
 woods and underwoods waywaters and water courses and all and singu-
 lar the appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of land belonging
 or in any wise appertaining unto the said William West & Crespy
 his wife do for themselves and all and every other person or persons
 whatsoever in witness whereof we the said William West
 and Christian his wife have hereunto set their hands and
 affixed their seals the day and year first above written -
