

193 county of Southampton have given granted bargained sold alien and confirmed and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said Mary Bittle for and during the term of her natural life, one negro woman by the name of Isabella and her children ^{and} ^{also} her children Hardy To have and to hold the said negro woman Isabella and her child ^{and} her child Hardy and her future increase unto the said Mary Bittle during the term of her natural life with remainder over at and after the death of the said Mary Bittle to the children of the said Mary Bittle living at her death, and their heirs forever and I the said Robertson Capell do hereby and agree to and with the said Mary Bittle and her childrens mothers and ofson following it wit that I the said Robertson will forever hereafter warrant and defend the title of the said negro to the said Mary Bittle for and during her life to her children of and after her death forever against the claims and demand of me my heirs executors and or of my person claiming or to claim by through or under me, their or any of them.
