This Indenture made this twenty day of August in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and ten between Exam Nick and Margaret his wife Samuel Nick and Patience Nick of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and John Hargrave of the same County and State of the second part Witnesseth that the said Exam Nick & Margaret his wife Samuel Nick and Patience for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred thirty nine dollars 25. cent to them in hand paid and upon the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto him the said John Hargrave the Interest which they have hitherto held in a certain piece parcel or tract of land lying and being in the County aforesaid and on the South side of Mottaway river containing seventy nine and 3/4 acres and bounded by the well known lines it being a dividend in the lower lands of which Christian Nick died seized and possessed and was set apart to the heirs of Lydia Nick dead To have and to hold to him the said John Hargrave his heirs his heirs and assigns forever, and they the said Exam Nick and Margaret his wife Samuel Nick and Patience Nick (for themselves their heirs executors & administrators doth warrant and defend
