plene by his last will and testament which has lawfully proved
 and admitted to record in the County Court of Southampton among
 other things devised to a certain Samuel Briggs of the state of North
 Carolina on equal interest with David M Edmunds George B
 Edmunds and Susan Edmunds in certain Slaves after the death of ~~the~~
 Elizabeth his wife and bequeathed also to the said Samuel Briggs
 an equal portion of his personal estate with the said David M
 Edmunds George B Edmunds and Susan Edmunds after the death
 of his said wife Elizabeth and whereas also the said Elizabeth
 widow of said Samuel Briggs died hath since intermarried with a
 certain William Bailey of the said County of Southampton who retains
 in his possession and claims during the life time of the said Elizabeth
 his wife the said Slaves and personal estate so as aforesaid bequeathed
 and devised to the said Samuel Briggs of the state of North Carolina
 with others and whereas the said Samuel Briggs is willing and anxious
 to sell and dispose of the right which he has in said Slaves and person-
 al estate by virtue of the last will and testament of Samuel Briggs and
 Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Samuel Briggs of
 the state of North Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of
 one hundred and forty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Wm
 Bailey the receipt whereof the said Samuel doth hereby acknow-
 ledge and forever acquit and discharge the said William
 Bailey doth by these presents relinquish and release all claim or
 right which he hath or might have in or to any ~~Slaves~~ ^{Slaves} or person-
 al estate by virtue of the last will and testament of said Samuel
 Briggs due to and in favor of said William Bailey his heirs executors and
 administrators or assigns In Testimony whereof the said Samuel
 Briggs hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this

2^d day of July 1810
