

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the Day of
 August 1810 This Indenture was acknowledged by Joshua Governor
 and Peggy his wife parties hereto she being first privately examined as
 the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made the 14th Day of October
 in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred & nine Between Timothy
 Tyrus William Lawrence and William Bailey their trustees of the County
 of Southampton of the one part — and Moses Johnson of the said County
 of the other part Witnesseth that the said Timothy Tyrus William
 Lawrence & William Bailey for and in consideration of the sum of two
 dollars to them in hand paid at or before the making of these presents
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said Timothy Tyrus
 William Lawrence & W^m Bailey doth hereby acquit and discharge the
 said Moses Johnson the said Timothy Tyrus William Lawrence &
 William Bailey hath bargained, sold alone relinquished and confirmed and
 by these presents doth hereby absolutely bargain sell alien relinquish
 and confirm unto the said Moses Johnson his heirs forever all right
 title claim or demand whatsoever which the said Timothy Tyrus William
 Lawrence and William Bailey may have in or to a certain tract or
 parcel of Land conveyed in a deed in trust by the said Moses Johnson
 to the said Timothy Tyrus William Lawrence and William Bailey of the
 County aforesaid containing two hundred acres more or less situate in County
 aforesaid also one acre more or less & half two be and furnished
 on will more fully appear by a deed of Indenture made by the said
 Moses Johnson to the said Timothy Tyrus William Lawrence and
 William Bailey on the in the in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and nine, and it as expressly covenanted and agreed by
 the said parties that well not at any future time set up, or lay claim
 or title to the said tract or parcel of Land which was so conveyed
 by Moses Johnson to them the said Timothy Tyrus William
