Witnesseth that the said James Clayton attorney as aforesaid
for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars
to him in hand by the said George Edwards at and before the
making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the
said James Clayton doth hereby acknowledge and thereof
aquit and discharge the said George Edwards his heirs admin-
istrators and assigns forever hath granted bargained and
sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien
enfeoff and confirm unto him the said George Edwards one
certain piece tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County
of Southampton and Parish of Netoway which said piece/parcel
and tract of Land is a part of the land devised to the above
mentioned Ethelbert Carr Williams by Benjamin Williams his father and is
generally called and known by the old place, and is bounded by Netoway
Swamp the lands of Said Barnes, Thomas Johnson Richard Rich-
ard Lewis Williams James Whitehead Edwin Williams & John Brown
together with all and singular the Edifices buildings yards gardens
Orchards woods ways water and water courses profits Emblements
hereditaments, with the reversion and reversions remainder and remain-
ders unto issues and services thereof to him the said George Edwards
as and to his heirs & assigns forever, To have and to hold all
and singular the appurtenances aforesaid to him the said George
Edwards and to his ~~heirs~~ only proper use and behoof for ever
and the said James Clayton for himself his heirs executors and
administrators hereby covenants do and with the said George Edwards
