 bargain sell assign release and confirm unto him the said Carr
 Darden all the said David Dardens right title, and interest in
 and to a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and
 twenty acres more in possession of his mother Honour Darden
 widow of Robert Darden decd it being the lott assigned to her
 under a decree of the county court of Southampton, where shown
 in the bonds of which the said Robert Darden died seized and
 as appears by the report of the commissioners filed in the clerk's
 office of the said County Court — To have and to hold the said
 bargained premises, to him the said Carr Darden his heirs and
 assigns forever and after the death of her the said Honour Darden
 together with all and singular the appurtenances profits and
 emoluments and to the said David Darden for himself his heirs
 executors and administrators doth and will warrant and defend the
 said bargain premises to the same belonging, against the lawful
 claims or demands of all and every person whatsoever to him the said
 Carr Darden his heirs and assigns forever In Witness whereof
