of October 1810 this deed of release was acknowledged by

This Indenture made this 3rd day of Septem^r
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & ten between Caleb
Ellison of Southampton County of the one part and John Washington
of said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Caleb Ellison
for and immediate satisfaction of the sum of forty eight dollars 12 1/2 cents to
him in hand paid or otherwise secured before the sealing or delivery of
these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge having granted
he assigned and sold, aliened and conveyed & by these presents doth grant
convey and sell in fee simple and confirm unto the said John Washington
