

This Indenture made this third day of May 1810 between the

Citizen of Southampton County of the one part Anthony Andrews
of said county of the other part, Wethersfield that the said Citizen for
remuneration and in consideration of the sum of seventeen pounds from shillings
and pence and dante^{to} to him in hand paid or otherwise secured before the sealing or
May 9th A.D. 1810 to him in hand paid or otherwise secured before the sealing or
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge
hath bargained & sold above unoffic^{er} and by these presents doth grant
bargain and sell above unoffic^{er} & confirmed unto the said Anthony Andrews
draws his hand & an certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in
the county of Southampton and on the south side of the said stream
and bounded as follows N.W. containing twenty two acres (or the
same more or less) beginning at a stump & said on draw^s former
line thence N. 73° E 3 1/2 pole a corner red oak thence S 10° E 3 1/2
pole to a corner adjoined in Ethelde^r Washington's line thence along said
Washington's line N. 5° E. 4 3/4 pole to a branch thence up the run of
said branch to a white Oak tree ^{thence} along a new line of Martin's
tract to a corner white Oak thence along said and across the new line
S 17° W 5 1/2 pole to the beginning or first station to have and to hold
the said tract or parcel of land to the said Andrews & to his heirs & to his
use behalf forever and the said Caleb Ellinow do further covenant
agree to and with the said Andrews that this present deed of bargain
& sale shall be to said Andrews his heirs & executors a good and sufficient
warrant against him as well as against the rights, claims & demands of
all and every other person & persons. In witness whereof the said Ellinow have
