This Indenture made this 11th Day of May
 in the year of Christ one thousand eight hundred and ten
 between James Taylor and Sally his wife of the County of
 Southampton at the one part and James Taylor of the same
 County of the other part Witnesseth that the said James
 Taylor and Sally his wife in consideration of the love and affec-
 tion which they bear for the said James Taylor their Son as well as for
 his better promotion, have given granted & confirmed and by these presents
 do give grant make over and confirm to the said James Taylor
 one certain tract or parcel of land in the County aforesaid, contain-
 ing one hundred and thirty acres more or less and bounded as
 follows Beginning on the white Oak neck at a white Oak
 a corner in Rich are Blunts Sam Cochs & the said Barton
 Taylors old line thence a straight line to a poplar on the west
 side of the Dry Mill then down a narrow branch to a willow
 Oak then a straight to a Cypress in the bear Swamp then along
 a line of mark track in James Simmons alias Brommings line to a
 Oak in the green fence a corner in Sam Cochs line then along the said
 Cochs line to the beginning and the reversion & reversion remainder
 and remainders with issues and services thereof and also all the right
 title Interest property claim and demand whatsoever of them
 the said Barton Taylor and Sally his wife of in and to the aforesaid
 tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances and every
 part thereof, So have and to hold the aforesaid tract
 or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances unto the said
 James Taylor his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof
 of him the said James Taylor his heirs and assigns forever and the
 said Barton and Sally for themselves their heirs and assigns to the
 said tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances
 against themselves and their heirs and against the claim and demand
 of all persons whatsoever unto the said James his heirs and assigns
 shall and will warrant and forever defend In witness
