forever, ~~that~~ ^{that} they shall erect and build or cause to
be erected and built thereon a house or place of worship for
the use of the members of the Methodist Episcopal ^{Church} in the
United States of America according to the ^{rules} ~~rules~~ and discipline
which from time to time may be agreed upon and adopted by
the ministers and preachers of the said church at their general
conferences in the United States of America; and in further
trust and confidence that ^{they} shall at all times forever hereafter
permit each minister (and preachers) belonging to the said
church as shall from time to time be duly authorized by the
general conference of the ministers (and preachers) of the said
Methodist Episcopal Church or by the yearly conference or otherwise
by the said general conference and none others to preach and expound
God's whole words therein and farther trust and confidence that if
after or any one or more of the trustees herein before mentioned shall
die or come to be a member or members of the said church ac-
cording to the rules and discipline as aforesaid then and in such
case it shall be the duty of the said minister or
preacher who shall have the pastoral charge of the said church
of the said church to call a meeting of the members
