 of and from all former gifts grants deeds Mortgages dower and  
 jointure (and of and from all manner of Incumbrances whatever  
 and convey the said tract Plantation or parcel of land unto the  
 said Pilgrim his heirs and assigns forever And certify the said Pilgrim  
 his heirs and assigns forever and them the said Samuel Vick and  
 Patience his wife Well Warrant (and forever defend us their  
 presents against the lawful claims of all and every person and  
 persons whatsoever (and whomever, In Witness whereof we
