Virginia Southampton County 1810

The Commonwealth of Virginia to Edmund Turner & William B Lockhart Gentlemen Justices of the peace for the County of Southampton and state of North Carolina greeting Whereas Harwood Jones, Hyder A Davie and Elizabeth T Davie his wife and James Exum and Ann Exum his wife have by their certain Indenture of bargain and sale dated the 14th Day of April 1810 conveyed unto Henry Blunt of the County of Southampton the fee simple estate of land in eleven hundred and eighty six acres of land be the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and state of Virginia And whereas the said Elizabeth T Davie cannot conveniently travel to the Court of our said county of Southampton to acknowledge the same therefore we do give to you power to receive the acknowledgment which the said Eliza T Davie
