At a court held for the County of Southampton the 17th day of Dec.
1782 the said Richard Barnes and Saml Bishop were acknowledged
by the said Jacob Barnes as of the County of Southampton a party thereto
before to be recorded.

This Indenture made the seventeenth day

of December One thousand eight hundred and two between John
Bishop and Tabitha his wife of the one part Zachariah Fingerson
and the other part both of the County of Southampton Witnesseth
that the said John Bishop & wife for and in consideration of the
Sum of forty five pounds twelve shillings current money of Eng-
land now half granted and by their presents to the grant (and confirm)
unto the said Zachariah Fingerson his heirs and assigns of a
certain tract or piece of land containing thirty two acres more or
less Beginning at a pine a corner tree in Richells line thence south
seventy five degrees east thirty three pole to a pine a corner tree
thence by a dividing line north thirty two degrees east one hundred
and sixteen pole to a white Oak a corner tree standing on the
edge of the river low ground thence by the said low ground to a
red Oak a corner tree thence south by a line of marked trees running
thence pole to the Beginning Together with all houses
gardens Orchards ways waters & water courses woods and underwoods
mines minerals and all other profits (and commodities thereunto
belonging and in anywise appertaining To have and to hold the said
Premises with the appertinances unto the said Zachariah Fingerson
his heirs and assigns forever with the reversion and reversions
thereof unto the said John Bishop and Tabitha for
