This Indenture made this 17th day of May in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and ten Between Jesse Browne of the County of Southampton of the first part William Blew and Henry Blew and Samuel Browne of the second part; and Joshua Fort of the town of Jerusalem of the third part. Witnesseth that whereas the said Jesse Browne stands Indebted to William Gordon of the County of Isle of Wight in the sum of twenty four hundred eleven and instant pounds shillings and pence from the first day of January 1807 and for security to the said debt hath given William Blew Henry Blew and Saml Browne joint obligors with himself in a bond executed to the said Wm Gordon and being directed to indemnify & make safe the said Wm Blew Henry and Saml Browne his Executors in the said debt
