in the year of our lord and Christ One thousand eight hundred and
 ten between David Pope and Nancy his wife of the one part and of
 the County of Spartanburg State of South Carolina and Amos Stephenson
 of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said David Pope and Nancy his wife for and
 in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to them in hand
 paid by the said Amos Stephenson at or before the sealing & delivery
 of these presents the receipt whereof the said David Pope and Nancy
 his wife hath bargained sold alien and confirmed unto the said Amos
 Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or divided
 of land Situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and
 containing by estimation One hundred twelve & half acres be the same
 more or less and bounded by the well known and reputed bounds
 being the tract formerly belonging to the Decd. John Wharton
