In Obedience to the within Commission to us directed we have personally waited on Mrs Mary Jarrett wife of William Jarrett and received her acknowledgement of the foregoing in the Indenture hereto annexed and examined the said Mary Jarrett privately and apart from her husband and she informed us that she had executed said Indenture voluntarily without the persuasion or threat of her said husband and she is willing the said Indenture should be recorded in the County Court of our said County of Southampton given under our hands and seals this tenth day of November 1810

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 11th Day of December 1810 This Indenture was presented by the Oaths of Benjamin Blunt Asaiah Williams & James Harris three of the witnesses hereto and with a commission for the purpose examination of Mrs Mary Jarrett and a certificate of its execution returned is ordered to be recorded

This Indenture made this fifteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten between Richard Kelso and wife Elizabeth of Southampton County of the one part and Patrick Bond of said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Kelso and wife for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid or other value unto have granted bargained and sold unto the said Bond one certain tract or parcel of land containing four hundred & 5/8⁰⁰ acres lying and being in the County of Southampton & bounded as follows to wit three hundred of which was his deviders of his father's land upon which being had to the report of the Commissioners will more fully appear and one hundred adjoining being part of Henry Ino Briggs tract and bounded by said Kelso's former line on the South and by Spring & Deleach on the west to a corner red oak and thence a new line of marked trees bounded by said Briggs line to the beginning black gum in a branch four hundred & 5/8⁰⁰ acres to the same
