This Indenture made this sixteenth day of January
in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand Eight hundred and eleven
Between Elizabeth Bell of Southampton County and state of Virginia
of the one part, and Britain Williams of the aforesaid other part
Witnesseth that she the said Elizabeth Bell for and in consideration
of the just and full Sum of fifty two pounds twelve shillings & ten pence
lawful money of Virginia to her in hand paid by the said Britain
Williams before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof she the said Elizabeth doth hereby acknowledge and there of
quit and discharge the said Britain Williams his heirs executors
and administrators and themselves thereof fully and entirely
satisfy contented and paid and she the said Elizabeth Bell
hath granted bargained and sold alim set over delivered in possession
and confirmed unto the said Britain Williams his heirs and
assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying
and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation
more or less one and three quarters acres of land to be the same
the aforesaid Swamp thence along a straight line of marked
trees to a person named Bee against Britain's house thence along a line
to a corner maple in the branch thence along a new line
of marked trees to a corner a white oak thence along the
