 Jeremiah Beal for and consideration of the just and full sum of
 fifty one pounds twelve shillings by the said Joseph Denson to him in
 hand paid before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof the said Jeremiah Beal doth hereby acknowledge and thereby
 acquit and discharge the said Joseph Denson his heirs and assigns
 forever and themselves hereunto fully and entirely satisfied
 and paid him the said Jeremiah Beal hath granted bargained
 sold aliened conveyed released between deceased and confirmed and
 by these presents doth grant bargain alien convey release between deceased
 and confirmed unto the said Joseph Denson and to his heirs and assigns
 forever all that plantation meadow marsh tract and parcel situate
 situate the new town situate lying and being in the County of Southampton
 and Parish of . . . tatarway containing by estimation
 one hundred acres be the same more or less comprising all the land
 which afore said and was assigned to the said Jeremiah Beal
