This Indenture made this 17<sup>th</sup> day of December  
in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand eight hundred and  
between Jacob Beal and Peggy his wife of the county of Southampton and  
Parish of Nottoway of the one part and Kinchen Edwards of the County  
and Parish aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said  
Jacob Beal and his wife Peggy for and in consideration of the  
full and just sum of One hundred and fifty One Dollars and  
fifty cents current money of Virginia the said Kinchen Edwards  
to them in hand paid at or before the concluding and delivery of  
these presents the receipt whereof the said Jacob Beal and Peggy his  
wife doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the  
said Kinchen Edwards his heirs and assigns forever and themselves  
fully and entirely satisfied contented and paid have bargained and  
altered unoffic<sup>al</sup> confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien up  
and confirm unto the said Kinchen Edwards his heirs and assigns  
one tract and parcel of land situate lying and being in the Parish of  
Nottoway and County of Southampton aforesaid containing by  
estimation fifty acres and a half being the same more or less and bounded  
as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a pine a corner tree of Dug  
Bryants line and Benjamin Beal running thence southw<sup>n</sup> by  
degrees west ninety four pole to a pine a corner of Dug  
Beals line thence south thirty five degrees west forty two pole to  
a small red oak a corner of another Williams and Benjamin Beal  
thence north seventy degrees east seventy four pole to a red oak  
a corner of within Williams thence north thirty five degrees east  
eighty seven pole to a red oak in Williams Williams  
thence north thirty five degrees east fifteen pole to a small black  
oak a new corner made on Jacob Beals line thence south west  
degrees east one hundred and twelve pole to a pine a new corner  
made on the said Jacob Beals line thence south fifty degrees east  
twenty pole to the first station west and water corner p<sup>ts</sup>
