This Indenture made the first day of September in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred & ten Between Jacob of the County of Southampton of the one part and Solomon Turner of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Jacob Turner for due consideration of the sum two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Solomon Turner the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge & thereof acquit and discharge the said Solomon Turner hath given to the said Solomon Turner a lease in fee simple & confirmed by his parents doth grant bargain sell alien infest & confirm unto the said Solomon Turner and to his heirs & assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation fifty acres more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a pine in Simon Boysting line thence running said Boysting line to a pine near the head of the River Brown down the said Branch to a small black gum near the road a corner tree thence running a line of marked woods down to a cedar a corner tree on the said Jacob Turners tract a straight line on the said Turner to a small stand on a small branch thence down the branch to the said Solomon Turners line then west corner along along the said Solomon Turners line to the beginning with all houses and houses edifices buildings gardens orchards woods trees ways waters water courses profits hereditaments & appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining & the reversion and remainder with power and profits thereof & any part thereof and all the estate rights title interest property claim & demand whosoever of him the said premises To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land & premises with the appurtenances to the said Solomon Turner and his heirs and assigns
