James Millar & James Jones Gentlemen Justices of the peace for
the County of Southampton granting whereas Thomas Vaughan and Rebecca
his wife have by their certain Indenture of bargain sale bearing date the
19th day of October 1810 conveyed unto William Pille the fee simple estate
of and in one hundred and eighty acres of land with the appurten-
ances lying and being in the County aforesaid and whereas the said
Rebecca cannot conveniently travel to our County Court to make
acknowledgment of the same therefore we do give unto you or any two
or more of you power to receive the acknowledgment which the said
Rebecca shall be willing to make before you of the conveyances
aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is hereto annexed
And we do therefore command you that you personally go to the
said Rebecca and receive the acknowledgment of the same (and examine
her privately & apart from her said husband whether she doth the same
freely and voluntarily without the persuasion or threat of her said husband
and whether she be willing that the same be recorded in the said
County Court) and when you have received her acknowledgment
(and examined her as aforesaid) that you distinctly and openly certify us
thereof in our said County Court under your hands & seals, (and
to us the said Indenture and this writ hereto annexed, Witness
Sam^l Hester clerk of our said court the 16th Day of October 1810
in the 33rd year of the Commonwealth
