This Indenture made the 21st day of October in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten Between
W^m Syms and Polly his wife of the state of North Carolina & Bartle
County of the one part and Timothy Syms of the state of Virginia
and County Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said
W^m Syms (and Polly his wife) for and in consideration of the sum of one
hundred and twenty seven pounds ten shillings to them in hand
paid by the said Timothy Syms at & before the making and delivery of
this indenture the receipt whereof the said W^m Syms and Polly his wife doth
fully acknowledge themselves to be fully satisfied & paid and thereupon doth
acknowledge and discharge the said Timothy Syms his heirs &c forever by these
presents hath given granted conveyed sold conveyed & confirmed by these
presents doth give grant conveyance sold conveyed and confirmed unto the
said Timothy Syms his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or
parcel of land containing by estimation eighty five acres be the same
more or less lying and being in the County Southampton and bounded
as follows Beginning at a pine standing in the road side a corner
tree of W^m Syms (and Benjamin Davis from thence a line of
marked trees to a white oak a corner tree of John (Cumberly line)
from thence a line of marked trees a lighted post a corner of
J^m Brock & William Bowden from thence a line of
marked trees to a pine a corner tree of John (Cumberly
