This Indenture made this seventeenth day of May in the year
of Christ one thousand eight hundred and eleven between Henry Blunt
of the County of Southampton of the one part and Richard Harrison
of the same County of the other part Whereas Henry Harrison Sr. dy-
deed bearing date the sixteenth day of October One thousand eight
hundred and four, of record in the Court of the County aforesaid,
did convey unto the said Henry Blunt a certain tract or
parcel of land, in trust to secure the payment of certain debts
therein particularly describe, together with Cost &c and whereas
the said Henry Blunt at the request of Henry Smith, One
of the parties interested, did first advertising the day & place of sale,
sell agreeably to the tenor of the deed aforesaid; and Whereas also -
Richard Harrison became the purchaser thereof. Now this Indenture
Witnesseth that the said Henry Blunt, in consideration of the premi-
ses also for and in the further consideration of the sum of three hundred and
ninety seven pounds, fourteen ^{pounds} and two pence Current money of Virginia
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold
and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell, alien in full and
confirm unto the said Richard Harrison his heirs and assigns forever
all that tract or parcel of land and Premises above mentioned the
boundaries whereof the deed aforesaid are particularly set forth &
describe also the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders,
rents, issues and services thereof, together with all the estate, right,
title, interest claim, property & demand of, in (and to the same) -
belonging or in wise appertaining, To have and to hold, the tract
of land and premises aforesaid with its appurtenances unto the
said Richard Harrison his heirs and assigns, to the only proper use
and behoof of him the said Richard Harrison his heirs and assigns
forever and the said Henry Blunt for himself, his heirs, executors
and administrators, unto the said Richard Harrison his heirs and assigns,
against the claim of himself his heirs & assigns, against the
~~claim of himself his heirs and assigns and all others claiming~~
under him (and one others whatsoever, the title to the aforesaid
tract of land & Premises well warrant & by these presents to give
defense In Witness whereof the said Henry Blunt hath
hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year
first above written
