This Indenture made this 30<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year of our lord One thousand eight hundred and nine between Joel Westbrook and Rebekah his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and John Knicker of the said County of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Joel Westbrook and Rebekah his wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirty five pounds lawfull money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Knicker before the sealing and delivery
