for my Son Henry R. Gilliam of Sussex County have given granted
(and confirmed) and by these presents do give grant and confirm
unto my said son Henry R. Gilliam, my negro man slave named
King, and my negro girl Sally both now in his possession, and here
in view to have hold and enjoy the said negroes, and increase
unto the said Henry R. Gilliam, his heirs executors, administrators
and assigns, to the only proper uses and behoofs of the said Henry
R. Gilliam, his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever
And I the said Elizabeth Gilliam, the said slaves & increase to
the said Henry R. Gilliam his heirs executors administrators and
