This Indenture made this eighteenth day of July in the year of our lord Christ one thousand eight hundred between Parks Vick and Rebecca his wife of the Parishes of Rottonway and County of Southampton; of the one part & Joseph Vick of the same Parishes and County of the other part. Witnesseth that he the said Parks Vick and Rebecca his wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid at or before the making and delivery of this presents the receipt whereof the said Parks Vick & Rebecca his wife doth hereby acknowledge and there of acquit & discharge the said Joseph Vick, his heirs executors and administrators by this presents be the said Parks Vick and Rebecca his wife. Hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Vick and to his heirs or assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Parishes and County aforesaid; containing by estimation forty acres (more or less) and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a pine in Largo Road a corner tree of John Ponds line thence a line of marked trees to a pine a corner tree of the glob's line of said Ponds thence a pine a corner tree of Joseph Vick's line thence a line of marked trees to the beginning with all the houses ways water courses Profits Commodities hereditaments tenements and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Plantation tract
