This Indenture made this tenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & eleven between John Appleswhite and Rebecka Appleswhite his wife of Southampton County state of Virginia of the one part, & William H. Comams of Surren County & William Briggs John Magee John Whitehead William Whitehead of Southampton County trustees in trust for the use and purposes herein after mentioned of the state of Virginia of the other part, Witnesseth that the said John Appleswhite and Rebecka his wife hath given granted released confirmed and conveyed and by this presents doth give grant release confirm and convey unto them the said William H. Comams William Briggs John Magee John Whitehead and William Whitehead trustees and their successors all estate right title interest property claim and demand whatsoever either in law or Equity which he the said John Appleswhite & Rebecka his wife hath in to or upon all and singular or certain lot or piece of ground situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and state aforesaid bounded and butted as follows (to wit) Beginning at a white Oak on the east side of the road from thence a south east by course to a elm a corner tree at the Approporn branch from thence down the said branch to a maple a corner tree thence a north Westly course to a hickory or corner tree on the road thence up the road to the beginning containing and being one acre of ground more or less together with all and singular the houses woods waters ways Privileges & appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the houses woods waters ways and privileges thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto them the said trustees and their successors in office former in trust that they shall cause to be erected and built thereon a house or place of worship for the use of members of the Methodist Episcopal Church in the united states of America according to the rules and Discipline which from time to time may be agreed upon and adopted by the Ministers and Preachers of the said Church at their general conference in the united states of America and in full trust and confidence that they shall at all times hereafter permit such Ministers and Preachers belonging to the said Church as shall from time to time be duly
