 I, David Darden of Swinford County North Carolina
 for and in consideration of the sum of forty dollars to me in hand
 paid before the unsealing of these presents by Carr Darden of Swinford
 County Virginia have granted bargained sold alien and conveyed
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell, alien set over and con-
 vey into the said Carr Darden all my reversionary interest in
 the following negro slaves, to wit: Nep Catich and Hannah (together
 with their future increase) which are now held & possessed by my
 mother Honour Darden, as her dower in the slaves of which my
 father Robert Darden died seized and possessed, together with all
 the interest which I may have in any other Property which at
 the death of the said Honour Darden she may leave subject to
 distribute amongst her heirs, hereby transferring to him the said Carr
 Darden his heirs and assigns (on the death of the said Honour Darden)
 the same right to claim demand receive and enjoy distribution in those
 slaves and other Property which I should or might have had if
 this or any other Conveyance of the same kind had never been
 by me made To have and to hold the reversionary interest
