is to say a life or down estate. hath given granted bargained &
sold unto the said Hannah Brooks, and her heirs and assign-
-former Six Acres of land, and bounded as follows Beginning at a
lightwood post a corner in Shaw Days line: running thence S 85
West 58 poles to a maple standing in the myrtle Branch a corner
thence S 81 East 20 poles to a pine in the said myrtle Branch
thence N 30 degrees East 46 poles to a post a corner in
Shaw Days line thence a Straight line to the first station
